

TOKYO OPEN 2024 - COURSE MAP NOTES (English Translation)

COMMON RULES

(1) OB Area

- Areas without a tee or goal setup
- Areas beyond OB lines described below
- * Exceptions: Holes 11, 14, and 15 have special areas.
- * Note: Paved areas on the fairway of Holes 3 and 7, and next to the goal in Hole 1, are in-bounds.

(2) OB Lines

- Boundary between artificial and natural surfaces
- Yellow dotted line: Border between youth soccer field and drainage ditch
- Blue dotted line: In-bounds side of the white rope
- Line connecting the in-bounds side of net fence posts
- * Applies to paths along Holes 1, 2, and 18 (red dashed line)

(3) Mandatory

- 1 penalty throw; continue from DZ (Drop Zone)

Single: Holes 4, 10, 11, 16

Double: Holes 12, 18

Triple: Hole 5

(4) Island Rules (Holes 11 & 14 [A/B islands])

- Tee area is considered OB
- If disc misses island: 1 penalty throw; play from DZ
- After disc stops, island boundary line becomes OB line
- Hole 14: From B island, if missed: 1 penalty; continue from lie

(5) Local Rule (Hole 15)

- Only C island and goal area are in-bounds
- First throw must land and stop on C island (local rule)
- If it doesn't: 1 penalty; play from DZ
- After landing on C island or throwing from DZ, apply normal OB rules
- * In line with standard rules, players may abandon a throw or re-throw; thus wording like 'continue play' is used.
